Mammoth Cave National Park was established in 1941 to protect the unparalleled underground labyrinth of caves, and the rolling hills above the Green River Valley which adorn the Park. Visitors have toured Mammoth Cave dating back to 1816. Many improvements have been made within the Cave since the first tour was given, but the need for a safer, more sustainable interior trail system was still a pressing matter. **DDS** recently completed a project working with The Tradesman Group, Inc. to provide construction layout and staking services, 3D Scanning services, and construction material testing services.
